Day 9

- Llandudno towards Hout Bay. Drive along the Atlantic Seaboard.
- Pass through Noordhoek and Scarborough. Later you will take to
- the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Enjoy the funicular ride

• aboard the "Flying Dutchman" and enjoy the unforgettable spectacular views. Later get the photo opportunity to take some pictures at the second southern most tip

• of the African continent. From here you will drive along the Indian Ocean coastline, where you can visit

• the beautiful Boulders Beach, and have the option to sit among the famous colony of Jackass Penguins.
