



CHINA 7D/6N : BEIJING - SHANGHAI



ITINERARY

Beijing is a city with more than 3,000 years of recorded history and a centuries-old glorious evolution. Evidence of human ancestry dating back to 700,000 years ago has been found in such places as Zhoukoudian in the southwest part of Beijing, where the remains known as 'Peking Man' were found.

Day 1: Arrival At Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, meet and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

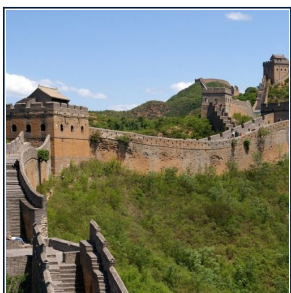
Day 2: Beijing Sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel. Great wall at Juyong pass, Jade factory, Photo stop at Olympic Stadium, Silk factory. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

Things to see and do

Changping Juyongguan Great Wall Juyongguan Great Wall, located in the Changping County, 60 kilometers from Beijing, and 20 kilometers from Badaling, was a strategic military garrison in the ancient China.

Day 3: Beijing City Tour



After breakfast at hotel. Tiananmen square and Forbidden city, Summer palace, free for shopping in Yaxiu market. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

Things to see and do

Tiananmen Square Tiananmen Square is a large city square in the centre of Beijing, China, named after the Tiananmen gate located to its North, separating it from the Forbidden City.

Forbidden City: The Forbidden City was the Chinese imperial palace from the Ming dynasty to the end of the Qing dynasty. It is located in the center of Beijing, China.

The Summer Palace: The Summer Palace in Beijing integrates numerous traditional halls and pavilions into the Imperial Garden conceived by the Qing emperor Qianlong between 1750 and 1764.

Day 4: Beijing To Shanghai

After breakfast at hotel. transfer to airport for flight to Shanghai, transfer to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Shanghai. Travel from Beijing to Shanghai

Day 5: Shanghai Sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel. People's square, Pearl factory, Shanghai museum, the 88th Floor of the Jinmao Tower, Bund area. Overnight in Shanghai.

Things to see and do

People's Square: Located at the heart of the city, it is the political and cultural center of this city.

The Shanghai Museum: The premiere museum of Chinese art and artifacts.

Jinmao Tower: China's third tallest skyscraper stands just beside Oriental Pearl TV Tower. The tower houses the Grand Hyatt Shanghai.

The Bund: The Bond, a waterfront area in central Shanghai. The area centres on a section of Zhongshan Road.

Day 6: In Shanghai

After breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Jade Buddha temple, Taobao Market, Nanjing road free for shopping. Overnight stay at hotel in Shanghai.

Things to see and do

Jade Buddha temple: The temple was destroyed during the revolution that overthrew the Qing Dynasty. Fortunately the jade Buddha statues were saved and a new temple was built on the present site.

Nanjing Road: Nanjing Road is the main shopping street of Shanghai, China, and is one of the world's busiest shopping streets. It is named after the city of Nanjing, capital of Jiangsu.

Day 7: Departure

After breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport for exit flight with sweet memories.
