Day Wise Itinerary

Beijing, the capital of the People's Republic of China is the center of the Nation's politics, culture and International exchanges and a modern metropolis full of vitality. The World's earliest record of Beijing came from the travel notes by Marco Polo, the young Italian traveler in the 13th century.

Here is how you will spend your time

Day 1

Day 1: Arrival At Beijing

Arrival at Beijing, meet and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

Day 2

Day 2: Beijing Sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel. Great wall at Juyong pass, Jade factory, Photo stop at Olympic Stadium, Silk factory. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

Things to see and do

Changping Juyongguan Great Wall



Juyongguan Great Wall, located in the Changping County, 60 kilometers from Beijing, and 20 kilometers from Badaling, was a strategic military garrison in the ancient China.

Day 3

Day 3: In Beijing

After breakfast at hotel. Tiananmen square and Forbidden city, Summer Palace, free for shopping in Yaxiu market. Overnight stay at hotel in Beijing.

Things to see and do

Tiananmen Square

Tiananmen Square is a large city square in the centre of Beijing, China, named after the Tiananmen gate located to its North, separating it from the Forbidden City.

Forbidden City

The Forbidden City was the Chinese imperial palace from the Ming dynasty to the end of the Qing dynasty. It is located in the center of Beijing, China.

The Summer Palace

The Summer Palace in Beijing integrates numerous traditional halls and pavilions into the Imperial Garden conceived by the Qing emperor Qianlong between 1750 and 1764.

Day 4

Day 4: Beijing To Xi'an

After breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport (train station) for flight (train) to Xi'an. Arrival at Xi'an later transfer to hotel via visit City wall photo stop, Big wild goose pagoda square with Fountain.

Day 5

Day 5: Xi'an Sightseeing

After breakfast at hotel. Full day tour to Terracotta, Crockery factory, back to city, visit Bell tower square and free for shopping. Overnight stay at hotel in Xian.

Things to see and do

The Terracotta Army

The Terracotta Army or the "Terracotta Warriors and Horses" is a collection of terracotta sculptures depicting the armies of Qin Shi Huang , the first Emperor of China .

Day 6

Day 6: Xi'an To Shanghai

After breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport for flight to Shanghai. After arrival meet and transfer to hotel. Overnight stay at hotel in Shanghai.

Day 7

Day 7: In Shanghai

After breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Jade Buddha temple, Pearl factory, the 88th Floor of the Jinmao Tower, Bund area, Nanjing road free for shopping. Overnight stay hotel in Shanghai.

Things to see and do

Jade Buddha temple

The temple was destroyed during the revolution that overthrew the Qing Dynasty. Fortunately the jade Buddha statues were saved and a new temple was built on the present site .

The Bund

The Bond, a waterfront area in central Shanghai. The area centres on a section of Zhongshan Road (East-1 Zhongshan Road) within the former Shanghai International Settlement.

Nanjing Road

Nanjing Road is the main shopping street of Shanghai, China, and is one of the world's busiest shopping streets. It is named after the city of Nanjing, capital of Jiangsu.

Jinmao Tower

China's third tallest skyscraper stands just beside Oriental Pearl TV Tower. The tower houses the Grand Hyatt Shanghai .

Day 8

Day 8: Departure

After breakfast at hotel. Transfer to airport for exit flight.
