



## WILD LIFE - INDIA - BANDIPUR - 2N/3D



## ITINERARY

Bandipur National Park:

Bandipur National Park in Karnataka is a tiger reserve with an area of 900 square km. In the dense moist deciduous forests of this area the upper canopy reaches heights of 30m and valuable hardwoods like teak and rosewood are also to be found here.

This is one of the finest habitats of the Asian elephant. Drained by the Moyar River, its open forest makes it easy for visitors to see the elephant and gaur in natural surroundings.

The park has good facilities for viewing wildlife, which include gaur, elephant, sambar, chital and even the occasional tiger or leopard. Among other mammals are the muntjac, the tiny mouse deer, wild boar, pangolin, giant squirrel, slender loris, langurs and macaques. The Park has about 250 species of birds and Malabar trogan, the Malabar pied hornbill, the great black woodpecker, the Indian pitta and the green imperial pigeon are part of its avian variety.

This is a good destination which can be added for almost all the tours starting from Bangalore and heading towards Ooty and Kerala. You can easily make a circuit covering Nagarhole, Bandipur, Mudumalai and B R Hills which are the prime jungles of the area.

General Information



Best time of visit: Throughout the year

Nearest Town: Gundulpet (20 km)

How to get there: Air:-Bangalore (200 km);

Bandipur National Park 2 nights & 3 days

Day 01:Arrive at noon at a Resort. Afternoon drive to the jungle in an open jeep for animal viewing. Overnight in the resort.

Day 02:Morning elephant joy ride / drive to the jungle for tiger tracking and bird watching. One can have good photographic opportunities. The jungle visits lasts for about three hours. Return to the resort for breakfast & lunch. One can walk around the surroundings with a tribal or go for a village visit. Afternoon drive to the jungle for animal viewing. Overnight stay in the resort.

Day 03:Morning jeep drive in the jungle. Depart for onward / return journey after breakfast  $\,$
