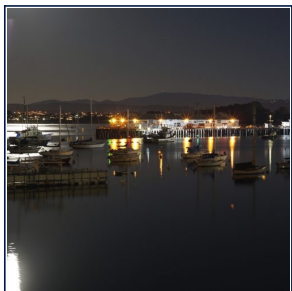


Day 3 : SAN FRANCISCO - BASS LAKE (2 NIGHTS)

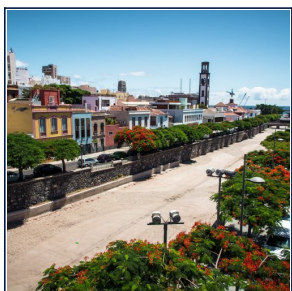
Day 4 : YOSEMITE NATIONAL PARK SIGHTSEEING AND FREE TIME

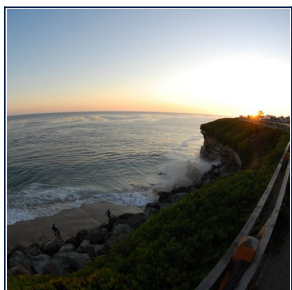
Day 5 : BASS LAKE - MONTEREY (3 NIGHTS)

Drive along the top-ranked Pebble Beach Golf Links and wonder how anyone can focus on their swing with such amazing views to distract them before sitting down to a delicious dinner.

In the afternoon, hang ten at the Santa Cruz Surfing Museum. Tonight, gather up the gang for a fun Farewell Dinner.
