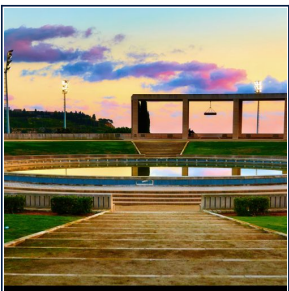
ITINERARY

Itinerary:

day 1 : Barcelona

Transfer from Barcelona airport to the hotel in Barcelona.

Leisure time to enjoy this Catalan city. shopping, going to a football match or enjoying the sun at the beach are all great ways of discovering Barcelona.

day 2 : Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Barcelona sightseeing based on a hop on-hop off bus. The tour will highlight all the things to do in the city so that you can hop on and off at your convenience at more than 44 stops. The key sights and world famous attractions of this fantastic city are included on the tour including the gothic quarter which is the centre of the old city of Barcelona. a great number of buildings are world heritage sites. especially remarkable is the work of architect Antoni Gaudi, which can be seen throughout the city; the Sagrada Familia cathedral, Casa Batlló, Casa Mila and Park Güell.

day 3 : Barcelona

Buffet breakfast at hotel in Barcelona. Half day excursion in Montserrat. Montserrat, the holy mountain, with weird shapes and rounded peaks that jut into the sky offering impressive views. an almost 1000 year old monastery hosts the oldest boys' choir in Europe. Located 1 hour drive from Barcelona.
overnight at hotel in Barcelona.

day 4: Barcelona - Madrid

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Transfer to Barcelona airport. Flight to Madrid. transfer from Madrid airport to the hotel in Madrid.
Madrid sightseeing based on hop on -hop off bus. one of the easiest and most comfortable ways of discovering Madrid.
Highlights: Gran Vía, Plaza de España, Habsburg old quarter, Puerta del Sol, Puerta de Alcalá, Paseo de la Castellana and the Real Madrid stadium, Santiago Bernabéu (tour of the stadium available).
overnight at hotel in Madrid.

day 5: Madrid

Buffet breakfast at hotel in Madrid. Toledo excursion half day on regular basis. Toledo is one of the Spanish cities with the greatest wealth of monuments. known as the “city of the three cultures”, because Christians, Arabs and Jews lived together there for centuries, behind its walls Toledo preserves an artistic and cultural legacy in the form of churches, palaces, fortresses, mosques and synagogues. this great diversity of artistic styles makes the old quarter of the capital of La Mancha a real open-air museum, officially a world heritage site.
overnight at hotel in Madrid.

day 6: Madrid - Segovia

Buffet breakfast at hotel in Madrid. Ávila & Segovia excursions. Transfers included. Ávila is one of the oldest cities in Spain, surrounded by very well preserved medieval walls from the XI century, resembles rather an immense castle. The old quarters hold an important number of Romanesque churches, Gothic palaces and its XII century cathedral, the first Gothic one built in Spain, is also fortified. Visit the outskirts of the cathedral, the Romanesque basilica of San Vicente, Mayor square and a brief walk through its old streets to see the convent of St Teresa. The city of Segovia is rich in historical monuments. Old Roman city, still preserves the magnificent Roman aqueduct. The elegant cathedral, and its Alcazar fortress, the most spectacular castle in Spain, are the most representative. Overnight at Segovia Parador. Modern, welcoming and surprising, this emblematic building offers the best views of Segovia.
